Entries Limited to 60 Dogs

Open to ALL dogs that are at least 12 months of age and individually registered with the AKC

This includes all AKC registered dogs, Foundation Stock Service (FSS), and dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) This competition is also open to mixed-breed dogs enrolled in the American Kennel Club's Canine Partners Program. (You may enroll in the Canine. Partners Program at the test.) Spayed or neutered dogs **are permitted.**

There will be two courses: one 300 yards for dogs shorter than 12" tall and flat-faced breeds; the other 600 yards. The smaller course must be completed in 90 seconds for a qualifying run; the longer course is allotted two minutes. The judge keeps the official time and decides the merits of the dog's performance.

Dogs may run only one time. Dogs who stop running the course won't qualify.

THE COURSING TEST IS A PASS-FAIL EVENT.

COLLARS. Most lure coursing people recommend dogs run **without** collars. Official regulations state: *Dogs may wear any collar except a "choke" collar, a collar with prongs or an electronic training collar. The collar should be snug to minimize the changes of getting hung up on something during the run. Owners should be aware that tags hanging from the collar could become entangled on something during the run. Owners may use clips or rubber bands to hold the dog's hair. The owner assumes responsibility for the safety of the dog with regard to the dog's collar and paraphernalia on the dog.*

ROLL CALL AND PRE-TEST BRIEFING at TWELVE NOON

All entrants assemble at the test location at 12:00 p.m.The Field Committee will confirm those entered are present. Entrants should respond "here" when their dog's name is called. Test procedures are explained, and questions answered.

INSPECTION

Immediately following close of entries, each entry will be inspected for lameness, fitness to compete, and females in season. All dogs inspected must be presented without tape, bandages or wrapping, or coverings of any kind. If, in the opinion of the inspection committee, any entry is found to be lame, unfit to compete or in season, they shall be excused from the test, and applicable entry fees shall be refunded. Substitution of dogs will be accepted at the time of roll call/inspection. Once inspection is finished, no substitution is allowed.

HUNTMASTER is responsible for field safety and therefore he is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. In service to this responsibility, he has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve a testing dog. Listen to the Huntmaster and follow his instructions promptly.

JUDGE'S decisions regarding the performance of an entered dog shall be final. Full discretionary power is given to the judge to withhold any and all qualifications for lack of merit. The Judge is responsible for ensuring compliance with the AKC Regulations on the field.

FENCES. The area is partially fenced and far away from roadways. Nevertheless, your dog should have solid recall before attempting a coursing ability test.

Entries Close Sunday, April 27, 2014 at noon or whenever entry limit is reached, **whichever comes first**. Pre-entries should be sent to:

Must be postmarked *no later than Friday*, *April 18*. If entry limits have not been reached, entries may be submitted in person at the FSCKC Dog Show all day Saturday, April 26th and Sunday, April 27th until noon. **Please pay with cash or check.**

An orange flat ribbon will be awarded to each dog who has a qualified run in the Coursing Ability Test. An orange rosette will be presented to any dog who complete a coursing title at this event.

Fort St. Clair Kennel Club will host their annual All-Breed Dog Show adjacent to the test course throughout the weekend.

Éntry fees may be refunded after the closing of entries if the entered dog, upon inspection, is found to be lame, unfit to compete, or in season.

No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or its members and representatives.

FSCKC's members, representatives, volunteers, etc, and the facility assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children or spectators.

All rights to televise, videotape, advertise, photograph, promote or otherwise exploit this event are vested in the club, or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the club.
