ELIGIBLE BREEDS & REGISTRY

Open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the FSS program, dogs with PAL numbers or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. A dog may enter only once per event. (An event number defines an event.) Females in season may not enter. Dogs requiring registry in Canine Partners must be spayed or neutered and are subject to a separate registration fee of \$19.00.

Not AKC registered? – NO PROBLEM! You will can register your Canine Partner with AKC.

REFUND of ENTRY FEES

Female dogs in season, lame dogs, or any dog that fails inspection
will be refused entry and entry fees will be refunded.

Refunds for other absences or withdrawals made after the event
pre-entry closing date (9.23.19) will not be made unless requested
in writing with a note from your veterinarian.

Coursing is an athletic activity that can tax a dog's physical strength. Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion.

*The Inspection Committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry into a test,
and in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded.*

All dogs run at the sole risk of their owners.

The Huntmaster is responsible for field safety and therefore he/she is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. In service to this responsibility, he/she has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve a testing dog.

Only the Lure Operator, Huntmaster, and Handler of the dog running in the course in progress will be permitted near the lure machine.

**A light blue flat ribbon with official time is awarded for each completed run.
New Title rosettes awarded for new Fast CAT titles earned at this event.**

We recommend using a plain buckle collar and lead. Muzzles are permitted

Flexi-leads, pinch collars, electronic training collars and devices are forbidden.

All dogs are inspected for soundness and measured prior to running each event. All female dogs are checked for estrus prior to running each event. Any entry found during inspection to be unfit to compete, lame, or in estrus is barred from competition and entry fees refunded.

Handlers must maintain control of their dogs at all times. Per the AKC, a \$5 fine will be assessed for any loose dog on the field that is not competing on the course in progress.

Any dog that eliminates on course or in the run-out area will receive a nonqualifying (NQ) score. A \$5 fine will be levied upon any handler who fails to pick up after their dog.

FSCKC reserves the right to alter the course due to field and/or weather conditions on the day of the test. Battery powered continuous loop lure machines are used. The lure consists of white plastic strips.

Children must be under control of their parents or guardians at all times.

Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to FSCKC, K9 Splash Zone, the AKC, trial volunteers or any dog(s) or other person(s) may be subject to a bench committee hearing and will be made to leave the trial site.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

Any decisions made by the event's officials regarding the performance of an entered dog shall be final. Full discretionary power is given to the event officials to withhold any and all qualifications for lack of merit. The event officials are responsible for ensuring compliance with the AKC Regulations on the field.

Entry fees will not be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or its members and representatives.

The club, FSCKC, K9 Splash Zone, its agents, members, representatives, and volunteers assume no liability or responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children or spectators before, during, or after this event. By entering this event, you agree to this provision.

NEW RULE per the AKC as of September 1, 2018 Dogs are not to be enticed through the course with anything other than the lure during its official run. This means you cannot run with your dog (on or off the track). You cannot use toys or treats to get them to come to you as they are running the track. You can use your voice and or hands to encourage them.
